Subject: Adult Protective Services (APS) Planning Process

The department has recently received several inquiries as to the required signatures on the Adult Protective Services (APS) Planning Process' Plan of Cooperation and Memorandum of Understanding. This communication will clarify and make modification to instruction based upon this inquiry. The APS Planning Process, as you know, is intended to support local efforts to identify and coordinate available resources, assess existing capacity, and develop a collaborative county plan for building system capacity. The eleven-month planning period provided the opportunity for \$50,000 in planning to county departments of job and family services (CDJFSs) for working with partners to collaboratively ensure that core requirements will be locally available by July 1, 2016. All counties must be in full compliance with legislatively enacted requirements and provisions no later than July 1, 2016.

Please note that Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 5101.612 requires that each CDJFS shall prepare a memorandum of understanding that is signed by all of the following:

- (1) The director of the county department of job and family services;
- (2) If the county department has entered into an interagency agreement with a local agency pursuant to section 5101.622 of the Revised Code, the director of the local agency;
- (3) The county peace officer;
- (4) All chief municipal peace officers within the county;
- (5) Other law enforcement officers handling adult abuse, neglect, and exploitation cases in the county;
- (6) The prosecuting attorney of the county;
- (7) The coroner of the county.

For purposes of the County Plan of Cooperation we will accept plans that have a simple majority (more than half) of the "chief municipal peace officers within the county." However, pursuant to ORC Section 5101.612 (A)(4) the memorandum of understanding must contain signatures from all chief municipal peace officers within the county.
