August 14, 2014

Medicaid Presentation

HealthCheck/ESTPD

- State must meet service screening measures set by the federal government
- Under title 19, must provide services and optional services to receive federal reimbursement

Autism Spectrum Disorder

- 25,000+ in the Medicaid database
- \$120 million

CPST – services provided through Mental Health

Medicaid in the School Program

- Based on IEP
- Must have parental consent
- Covers treatment, medical equipment and supplies
- Looking into covering transportation
- No Medicaid dollars for education

Mental Health Services

Behavioral Health Services	
Community Medicaid	Managed Care Plans

- Have pieces and parts that we need to put together to provide services
- Identifying gaps and looking for solutions
- Engage Process – a four-year grant for at risk kids between the ages of 14 and 21. The goal is to reduce expenditures and increase good outcomes – currently look at Wrap Around services
- Look creatively at financing, ie. State/federal funds, leverage funding
- Look at non-Medicaid spending including: home and community based services, support services and out of home services
- Coordinate care for Kids – an OHT group that is looking at process and workflows with a goal to improve outcomes and reduce costs
- Always looking to identify cross-agency and community needs and how to leverage resources to meet those needs

Hanging Issue:

- Providers are charging a bundled per-diem, not separating out Medicaid versus non-Medicaid services. This is a hardship for counties.
- Possible Solution: Set an up-front billing policy so counties know what they are paying for before a placement.
- Director Dungey would like a few more examples concerning this issue.
